Day 1 Depart USA Today you depart the US on an international flight to Chile. Meals and refreshments served on board.

Day 2 Arrive Santiago, Chile - City Tour Arrive in Santiago and transfer to your hotel. On our city tour, see San Francisco Church, European-inspired Barrio Paris & Londres and Barrio Concha y Toro, Plaza de Armas, the Cathedral, the National History museum, Santiago's main avenue "Alameda," and "Palacio de la Moneda." Enjoy vistas of Santiago and the Andes Mountains from San Cristóbal Hill, then go to the Providencia shopping zone. Lunch will be at a local restaurant today. (L)

Day 3 Santiago This morning greets you with the opportunity to explore Santiago on your own. This city of contrasts showcases the remains of its colonial past in stark contrast with the ultramodern, high-rise buildings of its financial center. Venture along at leisure to shop until you drop or just relax. Tonight, enjoy a welcome dinner at your hotel. (B,D)

Day 4 Santiago/Mendoza After breakfast, transfer for your full day panoramic bus journey crossing the majestic Andes. Pass the city of Los Andes, and Portillo, Chile's most important center of winter sports situated at the foot of South America's highest mountain, the Aconcagua. Cross into Argentina and see the "Puente del Inca" or "Inca Bridge." Pass Penitentes, Argentina's best-known ski resort, before reaching Mendoza. Along the way we will stop for lunch in a local restaurant. (B,L)

Day 5 Mendoza - Winery Tour - City Tour Head out to Mendoza's agricultural oasis, home to 70% of Argentina's vineyards. Learn about the wine making process and enjoy a wine tasting experience in the oenological center of South America. Afterwards enjoy a city tour showcasing the culture and history and its foundation by the Spanish colonizers four centuries ago. There will be time for independent exploration of Mendoza before we return to the hotel. Tonight, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. (B,D)

Day 6 Mendoza/Buenos Aires - City Tour Transfer to the airport for your flight to Buenos Aires, then embark on an afternoon city tour. See the Pyramid de Mayo, the Presidential palace, the Cabinet, and the Metropolitan Cathedral. View "The Obelisque." Enjoy history and modern-day musings at every turn as you discover its various neighborhoods, from San Telmo with its signature tango parlors; to European-inspired La Boca, and trendy Puerto Madero. Continue to La Recoleta, one of the most elegant neighborhoods of Buenos Aires, due to its European inspired architecture as well as distinguished Recoleta Cemetery where you can view the graves of notable people such as presidents, Noble Prize winners and Eva Peron. (B)

Day 7 Buenos Aires - Gaucho Tour Cultural Discovery Series - Today discover the charm of the Argentine Pampas with a visit to a local ranch outside of Buenos Aires. Estancia Santa Susana is located close to "Los Cardales" town, in the famous "Pampas" belonging to the province of Buenos Aires. You will be welcomed

with typical Argentinean Empanadas and drinks. Then you have the opportunity enjoy the charm of the Argentinean countryside by a “sulky”, or horse ride. The architecture of this region can be observed in a Spanish colonial-style house, “casco”, which features an authentic museum of that period. A typical Barbecue lunch with Argentinean wines will be served, followed by a show of folk music and traditional dances. The day will end with some typical activities of an estancia: regional Gaucho games such as the “carrera de sortijas”. (B,L)

Day 8 Buenos Aires - Tango Dinner & Show Enjoy breakfast at your hotel, then get to know the city at your own pace. Buenos Aires, the capital of Argentina, is a cosmopolitan place that showcases European cultural influences. During the day, many attractions beckon: museums, art galleries, shops, parks, tree-lined boulevards, and much more. At night opt for a visit to a “tango” bar or acclaimed local restaurant. Cultural Discovery Series – Tonight you will visit the famous south zone of the city where the majority of traditional tanguerías are located. The tango is the outstanding music of Buenos Aires, born from a mix of Cuban and Spanish rhythms, some polka, and according to some, also a bit of African music. Each song has a story to tell about the city, its history and its people. In spite of its humble origins, in the 1920’s, the tango rose to the salons of the upper classes. In 1920, this old colonial house was converted into the traditional bar, “El Querandi”. Today, this symbolic corner of Buenos Aires has been converted into one of those magical areas of the city where the spirit of the past returns and exists for its inhabitants and those who visit. It’s the ideal place for you to enjoy a farewell dinner and a traditional show. Overnight in Buenos Aires. (B,D)

Day 9 Buenos Aires to USA Breakfast at your hotel in Buenos Aires and get ready to take some of the samba life home! Transfer to the airport for your return flight. (B)

Day 10 Arrive USA Today you arrive back to the USA.

OPTIONAL IGUAZU FALLS EXTENSION

Day 9 Buenos Aires/Iguazu Falls (Argentine Side) - Iguazu Falls Tour After breakfast you will be transfer to the airport to board your flight to Iguazu Falls. Iguazu Falls, the 275 waterfalls of the Iguazu River straddling the jungle borders between Brazil and Argentina, are one of nature’s most spectacular creations. A 2-hour flight connects Buenos Aires to the city of Iguazu and both sides of the falls. The Brazilian side is farther from the tumblers but delivers a panorama and better view of the greatest section, Devil’s Throat. Here, 14 falls combine in the 330-foot fall, pounding the water below with such force that there is a constantly rising huge rainbow-spanned cloud of spray. The Argentine side offers such a close-up of the thundering water that most visitors wear waterproof raincoats. The Falls are shared by two Iguazu parks—the National Park in Brazil and the Nacional Park in Argentina—each has been designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You must visit both! Upon arrival you will transfer to your hotel with immediate departure for your tour to the falls. Be prepared for one of the most spectacular natural beauties in the world: Iguazu Falls with 275 thundering waterfalls. The Argentine side offers walking trails to explore the park’s rich flora and fauna and such right-up-close views of the falls that you can really feel and hear their awesome power. (B)



Buenos Aires

Day 10 Iguazu Falls (Brazilian Side) - Iguazu Falls Tour Today you tour the Brazilian side, starting from the park, which has a road leading to the start of the Cascades Trail, a moderate walk that takes you high above the river to a series of galleries with great views of the Argentine side. At the end of the path, walk down to a boardwalk which extends to the lower base of Devil’s Throat. Or, you can stay in the car all the way to the end and take a glass-enclosed elevator down. Next, enjoy a visit to the Bird Park: the park is located near the Iguazu National Park (Brazilian side). Experience direct contact with more than 1000 birds from all four corners of Brazil and from various parts of the world, many of them endangered. There are 16.5 hectares of lush Atlantic rainforest maintained to providing the best habitat for the animals. Many species found here are no longer in condition to continue living in nature. The idea is to create an environment where the animals can live happily. Besides visiting the aviaries and a butterfly house, you also see reptiles such as alligators and the anaconda. Come, learn, and have fun! Cultural Discovery Series: Visit the Indian village of Tekoa Yriapú and experience their day to day lifestyle. Learn about the history of the indigenous community and see how they’ve adapted to living in modern day Argentina. Tour the village and learn about the plants they use for cooking and medicine. Hear their traditional music, and support them by buying handmade arts and crafts. Return to the hotel late in the afternoon. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a Farewell dinner at the hotel. (B,D)

Day 11 Iguazu Falls to USA Breakfast at your hotel in Iguazu and get ready to take some of the samba life home! Transfer to the airport for your return flight. (B)

Day 12 Arrive USA Today you arrive back to the USA.
