- EXECUTIVE AWARD FOR LARGE BUSINESS**
A business owner, CEO, managing partner or top executive in a large company who has a proven success record as an outstanding business leader, is a leading force in her industry, and has had significant impact on the community.
- BRENDA VICKREY JOHNSON AWARD FOR SMALL BUSINESS**
A small business owner or CEO who has a proven success record as an outstanding business leader and has had a significant impact on the community. *A small business's size limitations will be determined by industry, based on the U.S. Small Business Administration's definition. For most, small business is categorized as fewer than 50 full-time employees.
- HOPE AWARD**
Through military, police/fire or other public service, this honoree places the welfare of others before her own and has made a single or ongoing meritorious contribution to the San Antonio community.
- PROMISE AWARD**
This exceptional leader has made a significant impact on business and the community in a short span of time, due to age or length of time in San Antonio.
- LEGACY AWARD**
A leader who has a longstanding record of success and has made a significant impact on the San Antonio community.
